
ABOUT SCIART EXCHANGE

Based on the Humans in Space Youth Art Competition begun in 2010, we will hold annual, international, multimedia art competitions inviting youth 10-18 years old to learn about space exploration and relay their visions of the future. After each contest, the artwork will be showcased in displays and performances worldwide.

These activities are a motivating, interdisciplinary, educational activity for children, employing the latest STEAM (Science-Technology-Engineering-Art-Math) education approaches. They will have broad appeal and be accessible to students from all backgrounds and socioeconomic levels. They will train much-needed communication, creativity and teamwork skills as well.

These recurring contests and tours will keep the public informed, excited and actively participating in the future of space exploration, as we progress to live, work, and do science on the Moon, Mars and further into deep space.






